

Guideline for scholarship students and applicants

Step 1: fill in the scholarship application form

Step 2: attach to the application

- your current curriculum vitae with your artistic history
- a current professional opinion of the teacher of your principal subject
- another professional opinion of a professor at the Berlin University of Arts

Step 3: audition

- duration 15 minutes
- three pieces of music from three different eras
- please provide your own accompaniment

Please write on a separate paper: composer, work title, movement, and the name of the accompanying person.

Auditions take place in October for the winter semester and in February for the summer semester.

Important:

Please take care that all the documents for the scholarship application, especially the necessary professional opinions, are ready before the end of the semester.

The application form must be truly and in person filled in.

Deadline for the application with all necessary documents is respectively January 20 for the summer semester, and August 31 for the winter semester. Please keep in mind that the compliance with the deadline and delivery of all documents is a precondition for the deliberation in the managing board.
